Kings & Queens Disco this Thursday!

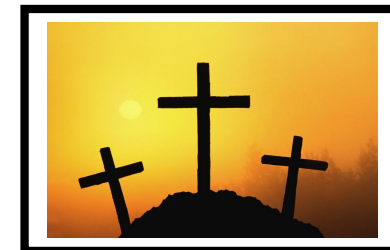

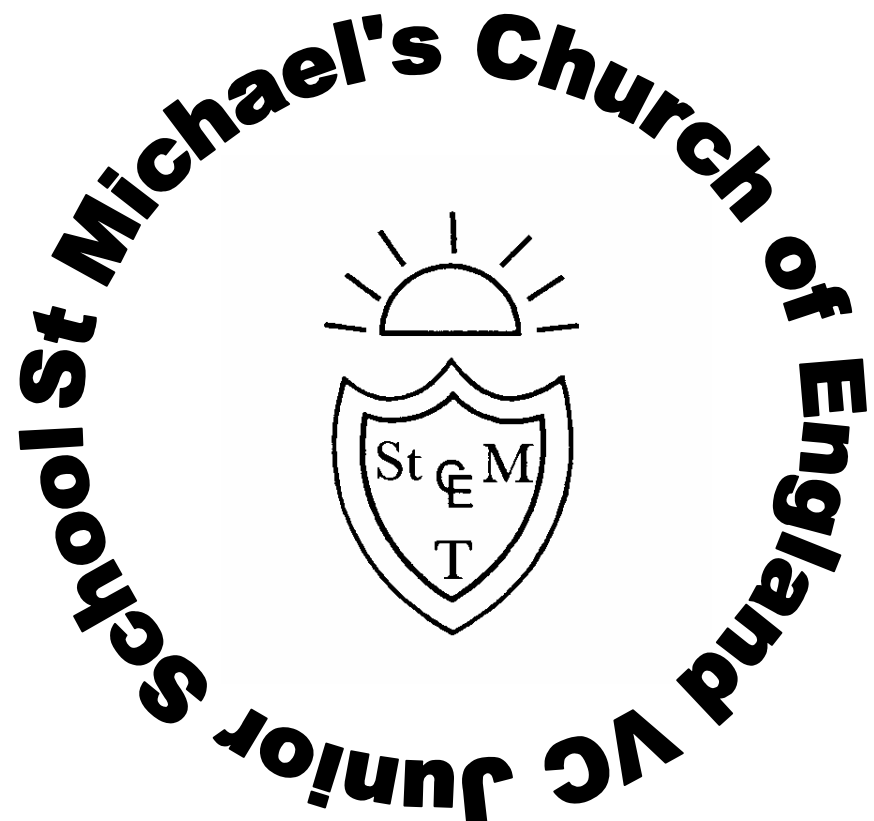
